


## EcoAgtube is faster, easier to navigate, and more user-friendly



#### **EcoAgtube**


- is a new video-sharing platform for all those with an interest in sustainable agriculture and sustaining the environment around the world to showcase your experience and local innovations.
- promotes agroecology and rural entrepreneurship through capacity development and South-South exchange of quality farmer-to-farmer training videos in international and local languages.
- is your video platform where you can upload and share your own video clips in any language to inspire, engage, empower and activate others in your country and across the world.

## More categories and subcategories have been introduced



- You do not need to register to view videos and clips on EcoAgtube, just browse and use the search facilities.
  There are 13 main categories and 88 sub-categories where you will find many different types of videos and video clips; these may be in many different languages.
- You can search for specific subjects of interest using the 'All Categories' dropdown menu at the top of the webpage.
- You can search for videos and clips in a specific language by using the 'All Video Languages' dropdown menu at the top of the webpage.

### You can comment, like, share and save to playlist




- By registering, you can upload your own videos and clips, and also make comments and recommendations, 'likes' or 'share' or 'save to playlist', on other videos on the site.
- You can also share videos on other social media channels, such as Facebook and Twitter. In addition, you can report any videos if you find them unsuitable or offensive by using the 'report this video' button to let us know what the issue is so that we can take appropriate action.



#### You can now find the status of uploaded videos

- Please make sure that your video does not contain any reference to agrochemicals (pesticides or fertilizers) or GMOs, as it will not be allowed on EcoAgtube.
- You must be logged in to upload any videos or clips. Once logged in, select the 'upload video' tab and browse to select your video. You can also copy and paste a URL from another site such as YouTube and Vimeo.
- All major and common video file types, such as MP4, MOV, 3GP, and WMV are acceptable for upload.
- You must fill in the additional information required, including title, description, the language of the video, and select up to 3 of the categories.
- Once the video has been uploaded, it will be available for moderation by the EcoAgtube team, only when approved will the video be available on the EcoAgtube site and within your profile.

## You can review the statistics on your videos and create your own channels




#### Search is much simpler

- You can also search by 'Video Title or key words' at the top of the webpage.
- On the homepage, there are also four rows of suggested videos for you to explore.
  - 1. Latest Videos
  - 2. Featured Videos
  - 3. Popular Videos
  - 4. Featured Category
- In addition, there is a row that shows the Top Channels.
